## Cleveland City Schools Elementary Student Bus Contract 2014-2015



The top priority of the Transportation Department of Cleveland City Schools is the safety of your children. In order to provide the safest and most efficient transportation, we need your cooperation to see that students understand the importance of and follow bus safety rules. Please review the safety rules with your child and become a partner with us by signing the behavior contract so that we will all have a clear understanding of the expectations of the Transportation Department. Education is your right, transportation is a privilege, don't abuse it. Tennessee State Board of Education States: "A pupil shall become ineligible for pupil transportation when his behavior is such as to cause dissension on a school bus, or when he disobeys State and Local Rules and Regulations pertaining to pupil transportation." This contract must be returned to your teacher within two weeks in order for your student to continue to receive transportation services. And remember, always practice safety.

- 1. While riding the bus students are under the complete supervision of the driver/monitor and shall obey the driver's first request.
- 2. Students will have seats assigned by the driver/monitor. Walk to your assigned seat in an orderly manner and remain seated for the entire ride.
- 3. Drugs, tobacco products, weapons, knives, sharp objects, or pets are not allowed on the bus.
- 4. Keep the bus clean. No eating, drinking, or littering on the bus.
- 5. Use a quiet voice. Do not speak loudly or shout, throw objects, use profane language, or fight. For everyone's safety, do not distract the driver through misbehavior.
- 6. Keep aisles clear and keep hands and arms to yourself and inside the bus. Students should not make gestures or shout to anyone inside or outside of the bus.
- 7. Respect the property of others. Do not take or damage what is not yours. Students or their parents will be expected to pay for any damages they cause. Students may be suspended from riding the bus until payment has been made.
- 8. Students shall not ask the driver to let them off the bus at any other location except at their regular stop unless there is prior written permission of the parents and principal.
- 9. Students must not tamper with any safety devices such as emergency exits, fire extinguishers, radios, etc. The use of any camera, video or recording devices is prohibited.

## Minor Offenses: **Disciplinary Action for Minor Offenses:** Eating/drinking on bus First Referral — Written Warning to be taken to parent by student. Failure to remain seated Second Referral — Letter to Parent to be taken to parent by Improper boarding/departing student and returned to the driver signed by the parent. Loud, rude or abusive behavior Third Referral — 3-day Bus Suspension and Conference with Profane language or obscene gestures Parent(s). Pushing or tripping; Hanging out of window Fourth Referral — Suspension of riding privileges for ten (10) Horseplay: Throwing objects (minor at driver's discretion) days, in addition to parent conference. Other conduct prejudicial to good order or discipline or Fifth Referral — Suspension of riding privileges for the remainder effects the safe operation of the school bus of the year.

## Major Offenses:

Possession of articles of an injurious or objectionable nature

Possession/use of tobacco Bullying or threats; Fighting Refusing to obey driver

Profane language/cursing directed at the bus driver Tampering with bus equipment or destruction of property

Unapproved use of emergency exits on bus Throwing objects (major at bus driver's discretion)

## **Disciplinary Action for Major Offenses:**

First Offense — 5-day suspension and parent conference.

Second Offense – 10-day suspension and parent conference.

Third Offense — Suspension of riding privileges for remainder of the year.
